TODAY'S GAME: Casper will look to win its first series since the first week of June in game two of a three game series with Hastings today. The Horseheads already cost Hastings a chance to finish at .500 by defeating them yesterday. Casper can also keep hope alive for a 20 win season and can achieve the win mark by sweeping the Sodbusters. Wyatt Gilbert will take the hill for Casper today, hoping to rebound from a rocky performance his last time out.

LAST TIME OUT: The Horseheads defeated the Hastings Sodbusters 7-3 last night behind strong pitching from starter Tyler Naumann and reliever Kobe Stoner. Naumann went seven innings, allowing three runs on six hits. Stoner then came in and pitched two scoreless innings to close out the game. The Horseheads had to come back from a 3-0 deficit to get the win. Hastings scored in the opening inning after Shawn Barrowdale scored on a Jake Oblas RBI single. Through the middle innings the game remained 1-0 as Naumann and Hastings reliever Vinny Schmidt traded scoreless innings before Hastings scored two more runs in the bottom of the sixth. Then in the seventh Casper put up six runs on six hits to take the lead. Casper added one more run in the eighth inning to snap a two-game losing streak.

ONLY THE ROAD REMAINS: Casper will play the rest of its games on the road. The Horseheads wrap up their season with this three game series in Hastings.

ALL-STARS: A total of seven Horsehead players were selected for the Expedition League All-Star Game, in Hastings, Nebraska. Andrew Garcia, Daulton Mauldin, Connor Lowrie, and Charles Steele were the position players selected, while Alec Myers, Josh Overstreet, and Jesse Carr were the pitchers honored. Myers and Overstreet did not attend the game due to scheduling conflicts and Carr, picked as Myers replacement, did not play in the game while Garcia ended up smacking an RBI triple in the contest.

PLAY FOR PRIDE: With the playoffs already set the Horseheads will be playing for pride and player development in the last two games. Casper can still get to 20 wins on the season, but they have to sweep Hastings to do so. Casper can also send Hastings into the playoffs slumping if they can pull off the road sweep. Hastings meanwhile will likely try to fine-tune their lineup and performance going into a single elimination playoff game at Western Nebraska. The Sodbusters will play the Pioneers in a win or go home playoff game on Tuesday. The winner advances to the best of three Expedition League Championship Series.

WEATHER: Temperatures in the low 80s are scheduled for tonight with a possible thunderstorm in the area.
